DPW Operations & Finance: The road crew have been plowing and sanding roads. They are about half way through the sand in the shed. They replaced a battery in the grader. Everything is going good.

Culvert & Bridge Report:

Lake Street Culvert: Dusty will apply for a Structures Grant & Class 2 Road Grant for 2022.

Basin Harbor Road Culvert: The Basin Harbor Road Culvert committee met with Dubois & King to score three of the five applicants for the inspection phase of the project and as a result choose GPI for that phase. This will be put out to bid on March 25th. Contracts for Dubois and King and Otter Creek Engineering have expired and need to be updated. David made a motion to approve of amending the contacts to extend them to the end of 2021 with Tim as the agent to do so. Joan seconded, motion

Mountain Road Culvert: The Town has received the money from the grant the project is complete.

Rattlin Bridge Road Culverts: Land trust has agreed with technical mistakes within the deeds. The Town needs to send \$250.00 to the Land Trust and then they will sign the deeds. Tim will talk with Audet's and Foshay's to make sure they agree with the right of way agreement.

Middle Road Bridge: Dusty will resubmit the structure grant.
